**Overview:** Plano welcomes hundreds of meetings and conventions every year, and it's no wonder. This vibrant, cosmopolitan city located in close proximity to two major airports brims with lodging and dining options, attractions and amenities that make for seamless, productive and memorable gatherings. The city boasts a trifecta of walkable dining, shopping, and entertainment enclaves, each with an anchor headquarter hotel and plenty of meeting space, both indoors and out. A major upgrade to the Plano Event Center brought even more state-of-the-art outdoor meeting space to the city. But it isn't just the work day and after hours amenities that make for great meetings. Visit Plano is staffed by adedicated professionals who understand that now more than ever, meetings need to deliver the utmost in value. They are here to help maximize the success of every gathering.

**Transportation:** **Air:** Plano has quick and convenient access to two major airports – **Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport** ([dfwairport.com](http://dfwairport.com)) and **Dallas Love Field** ([dallas-lovefield.com](http://dallas-lovefield.com)). Several major airlines service these airports with daily nonstop flights, including American Airlines, Continental Airlines, Delta Airlines and Southwest Airlines.

**DART Rail** ([dart.org](http://dart.org)): Visitors to Plano can travel throughout the Dallas-Fort Worth area via the Dallas Area Rapid Transit System (DART) Rail Line from two locations in Plano: Parker Road Station and Downtown Plano Station. The Silver Line Regional Rail, which spans Plano to DFW Airport, will open between late 2025 and early 2026 with two stations in Plano.

**Bus:** Local bus service is also provided by DART. For schedules, visit [dart.org](http://dart.org) or call (214) 979-1111.

**Ground:** Plano is easily accessible from any location in the Dallas-Fort Worth metropolitan area. Major thoroughfares heading north and south include the Dallas North Tollway, State Highway 75 and Preston Road. East and west thoroughfares include State Highway 121, Highway 190 (President George Bush Turnpike) and Interstate 635.

**Shuttle/Taxi/Ride Share Service:** Travel to and from both airports and around the Dallas-Fort Worth area is available through several area transportation companies.

**Climate:** Plano enjoys a temperate Sunbelt climate with mild winters and hot summers. The average year-round temperature is 66 degrees. January is the coldest month, with an average temperature of 44 degrees, and July is the hottest month, with an average temperature of 86 degrees.

**Meeting Assistance:** Visit Plano, named 2025 Destination of the Year by the Texas Travel Awards, offers a wide variety of top-tier convention and meeting facilities and complimentary services. **Convention/Meeting Facilities:** Plano offers first-rate convention and meeting facilities. In addition to the city's convention center, Plano Event Center, there are a variety of Plano hotels, private venues, and even a community college all offering exceptional meeting facilities for every size of group and for every budget:

- **Plano Event Center** ([planoeventcenter.org](http://planoeventcenter.org)) was voted Best Meeting & Event Venue, Best Holiday Venue, Best Caterer, and runner-up for Best AV Provider and Best Team Building Venue by *Texas Meetings + Events* in 2018 and is consistently awarded a Readers' Choice Award from *ConventionSouth*. The renovated Plano Event Center provides more than 86,400 square feet of flexible function space that comfortably accommodates up to 5,000 people. Plano Event Center has undergone a significant courtyard renovation to significantly

expand upon programmable and rentable spaces for outdoor events. The new features provide extensive shaded areas and expanded hardscape to accommodate receptions, impromptu meeting spaces and live entertainment.

- **Cambria Hotel & Suites Plano-Frisco** ([cambriasuitesplano.com](http://cambriasuitesplano.com)): Located just minutes from The Shops at Legacy, Legacy West, and The Boardwalk, the 129-room Cambria Hotel Plano-Frisco features more than 2,400 square feet of meeting space and has oversized guest rooms that have separate living, working and sleeping spaces. All four meeting spaces are equipped with high-tech audio and visual equipment.
- **Collin College** ([collin.edu](http://collin.edu)): Collin County Community College Plano Campus features the Living Legends Conference Center, a full-service facility that can accommodate up to 600 in theater-style seating or 400 for banquets. The center can also be divided into sections to accommodate smaller seating layouts for seminars, meetings and other events. The college also provides professional catering and audio/visual services.
- **Courtyard Theater** ([planostages.com](http://planostages.com)): Referred to as the “hidden jewel of Plano,” the beautiful Courtyard Theater, located in the Haggard Park Historic District in downtown Plano is a 321-seat, proscenium-style theater. With a large stage and spacious lobby, the venue is the perfect place for receptions, recitals, stage plays, musicals, concerts, meetings, and private parties.
- **Event 1013** ([event1013.com](http://event1013.com)): Event1013 is a stylish, award-winning, Texas State Landmark venue where you’ll find an alternative, urban, and upscale setting to hold a successful business meeting or event. Event1013 blends authentic architecture, vintage charm, and warm character with

technology and sustainable modern conveniences and finishes. There are two main rooms for your use: The Main Gallery, which is the original brick and hardwood storefront, and The Raw Garden, a more casual, organic indoor garden space.

- **Fowling Warehouse** ([fowlingwarehouse.com](http://fowlingwarehouse.com)): Fowling Warehouse features 71,000 square feet of fun including 40 fowling lanes, bottoms-up draft beers from two 50-foot Texas-sized bars, 300" TVs, and private event spaces including an 11,000 square foot VIP toom with 6 fowling lanes and its own bar. Fowling Warehouse can accommodate groups from 2-1200 for personal and corporate events, and offers a wide variety of food and beverage options for your guests.
- **Haywire** ([haywirerestaurant.com](http://haywirerestaurant.com)): Texas tried-and-true gets an urban refresh. Haywire takes the Texas dining experience to a new level with cuisine that is at once hearty and refined. This three-story restaurant features five unique private dining rooms for up to 70 guests: a whiskey lounge, maverick in-door dining room, a box garden terrace, and a rooftop terrace lounge with its own Airstream trailer.
- **Hilton Dallas/Plano Granite Park** ([dallasplanogranitepark.hilton.com](http://dallasplanogranitepark.hilton.com)): The 299-room Hilton Dallas/Plano Granite Park Hotel provides the space, style and personalized service guests expect for meetings and events. A permanent sound and light system and entertainment roof structure along with comfortable and convenient restroom facilities and plenty of free parking make this the perfect setting for an evening under the Texas sky or for a concert, festival, or other special event.
- **Renaissance Dallas at Plano Legacy West** ([Marriott.com/dalbp](http://Marriott.com/dalbp)): As versatile as they are distinctive, the meeting spaces at Renaissance Dallas at Plano Legacy West Hotel offer fearless design and state-of-the-art technology. From seminars for 10 to receptions for 1200, the hotel's indoor and outdoor meeting spaces provide an extraordinary backdrop for virtually any event from small seminars to large corporate banquets.

**Districts:**

Plano has several walkable entertainment, shopping, and dining districts with anchor hotels.

- **Downtown Plano Arts District**  
(visitdowntownplano.com): Visit more than a dozen restored historic homes, the Interurban Railway Museum, and walk along authentic brick streets to discover an eclectic collection of antique shops, and boutiques selling everything from handmade jewelry to home décor and pottery. Catch a show/performance at Courtyard Theater, Cox Building Playhouse, or McCall Plaza, or see the artists in residence. Check the performance venue calendars for schedules and show times.
- **Legacy West** (legacywest.com): Opened in June 2017, this “city within a city” is the largest mixed use destination in North Texas and the perfect place to play, shop, dine, and stay. Besides serving as office space for several high profile companies including Toyota Connected North America, Liberty Mutual, Boeing Global Services, JPMorgan and more, the 255-acre development boasts 415,000 dynamic square feet of open-air retail and restaurant space. Legacy West adds to Plano’s already vibrant dining scene with restaurants that satisfy every craving, whether for steak or a good old-fashioned milk shake, French bistro fare or a red velvet cupcake.



For those who can't decide, **Legacy Hall** ([legacyfoodhall.com](http://legacyfoodhall.com)) has it all. In this one-of-a-kind artisanal food hall at Legacy West, visitors can wander over 20 stalls and bars to meet local purveyors and sample everything from lobster rolls and sushi to old fashioned hamburgers and duck fat fried chicken. There is also has an on-site brewery and an outdoor live entertainment stage.

Legacy West's shopping offerings run the gamut from fashion to furnishings to cosmetics and even electric cars. Its luxury retailers include: CHANEL Fragrance & Beauty, David Yurman, Golden Goose, Gucci, Louis Vuitton, Tiffany & Co. After a day of retail therapy, shoppers won't have to go very far to set down their spoils, since this urban village is anchored by the Renaissance Dallas at Plano Legacy West Hotel.

- **The Shops at Legacy** ([shopsatlegacy.com](http://shopsatlegacy.com)): This urban district is part of a 168-acre master planned development of boutique retail, best-in-class restaurants, and an anchor hotel, the Marriott at Legacy Town Center. Visitors will discover an expansive selection of upscale stores, independent boutiques and chic dining in an inviting outdoor setting.
- **The Boardwalk at Granite Park** ([boardwalkgranitepark.com](http://boardwalkgranitepark.com)): Situated across from the luxurious patio of the 299-room Hilton at Granite Park, this 30,000 square foot expanse features a variety of restaurants with patios serving burgers, gourmet biscuits, southern California boardwalk-style cuisine, brew pub fare, and more. There are also beachy deck chairs that afford a great view of the water feature and live music stage.
- **The Shops at Willow Bend** ([shopwillowbend.com](http://shopwillowbend.com)): This picturesque and upscale shopping center boasts more than 150 stores, including Neiman Marcus and Macy's. The newest addition to The Shops at Willow Bend is **The District at Willow Bend** transforming the mall into a shopping, dining, and entertainment destination. The District is a new restaurant area that is home to local chef-driven restaurants and a grand entrance to the property.

**Attractions:**

Visitors will find that Plano has a surprising number of attractions right in its own backyard:

- **ArtCentre of Plano** ([artcentrefofplano.org](http://artcentrefofplano.org)): The ArtCentre of Plano showcases the work of local and national artists. The ArtCentre recently relocated to the renovated Saigling House, a historic downtown Plano landmark.

- **Crayola Experience** ([crayolaexperience.com](http://crayolaexperience.com)) With 60,000 square feet of attractions, Crayola Experience is Texas' most colorful destination for interactive, creative play. Guests typically spend 3-4 hours exploring the 22 hands-on attractions. Kids of all ages can embark on a wonderful, whimsical adventure with such unique experiences as starring in their very own coloring pages, naming and wrapping their very own Crayola crayon, learning how crayons are made in a live manufacturing show and so much more.
- **Fowling Warehouse** ([fowlingwarehouse.com](http://fowlingwarehouse.com)): Fowling is a unique and entertaining game that merges football with bowling and is perfect for small or large groups. It's as easy as throwing a football at ten bowling pins until someone knocks them all down. Fowling Warehouse's Plano location is the first in the south, their largest venue, and the first venue with full food & beverage options! This is a perfect indoor activity for adults, older kids and teens.
- **Go Ape! Treetop Adventure Course** ([goape.com](http://goape.com)): Looking for a unique team-building activity? Glide over the forest canopy at Plano's Go Ape! Zip lines, Tarzan swings and suspended obstacles bring out your inner monkey and provide a fun challenge amid 800 acres of natural beauty at Texas' first Go Ape location.
- **Heritage Farmstead** ([heritagefarmstead.org](http://heritagefarmstead.org)): This four-acre museum preserves a way of life during the height of prosperity in the early 1900s. The beautiful Victorian home and 12 outbuildings was the hub of a 360-acre farm operated by colorful local resident Ammie Wilson.
- **Interurban Railway Museum** ([planoconservancy.org](http://planoconservancy.org)): This museum brings Plano transportation history back to life. Once a vital part of the Texas Electric Railway that ran from Denison to Waco from 1908 to 1948, the Interurban is one of the original electric cars that ran on the tracks through Plano. Next to the station is car 360, one of the original cars that carried mail and passengers. This is the only station remaining from Sherman to Dallas. The facility also includes an area that houses a colorful display on Plano history.
- **PINSTACK** ([pinstackbowl.com](http://pinstackbowl.com)): Plano is home to North Texas' first state-of-the-art bowling and active entertainment destination. PINSTACK is a 50,000 square foot venue featuring a 28-lane bowling experience, ropes course suspended 20 feet above the gaming center, two-story laser tag, bumper cars, LED lit six-lane rock climbing walls, hundreds of

interactive games and simulator technology. The facility also has a full-service restaurant, outside bar area, covered patio with fire pits, big screen TVs and ample seating. PINSTACK also offers a luxury VIP bowling area for private parties.

- **Southfork Ranch** (southfork.com): Relive some memorable moments from the television series “Dallas” at Southfork Ranch in nearby Parker. The “Dallas Legends: Fact To Fantasy” exhibit features such memorabilia as the gun that shot J.R., Lucy’s wedding dress and video clips from the popular TV series. Horseback trail rides are also offered.
- **The Texas Pool** (texaspool.org): The historic Texas Pool is 168,000 gallons of saltwater shaped like the great State of Texas and is officially a National Landmark listed in the National Register of Historic Places. The pool is open Memorial Day to Labor Day and features a diving board, two water slides, an island, and a shallow “South Texas” wading area for small children and parents.
